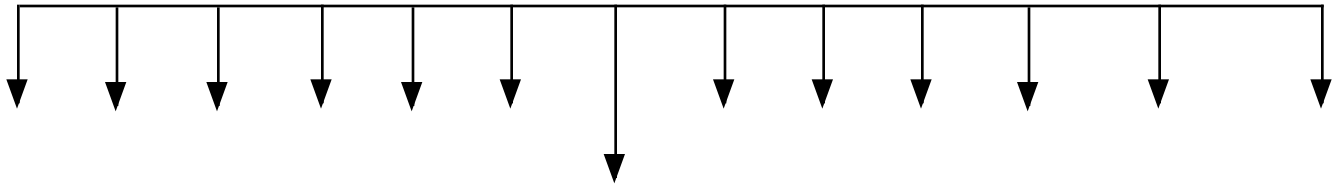




Hockey Canada

Hockey North officially became a Branch in 1998

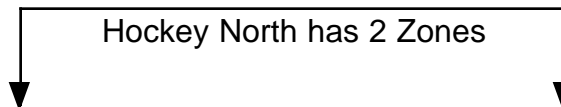


Responsibilities:
