STANDARDS FOR ON-ICE OFFICIALS

18 May 2007

The Association has adopted the following standards for on-ice officials:

- The minimum age for a official is first year Bantam (13 years old).
- Adult officials should be on the ice for Bantam, Midget, and Female games.
- Pee wee games should have at least one adult or, at the least, a midget aged official who is capable of controlling games involving contact.
- Junior officials should be at least two age groups older than the players that they are refereeing.
- The Referee Association shall adequately supervise officials to ensure that they meet technical standards.
- Association games which did not meet these standards may be cancelled.
